We have raised over \$10,000 for Track Attack at this time. We have had more than 40 corporate sponsorships and are incredibly grateful for the generosity of our community members!

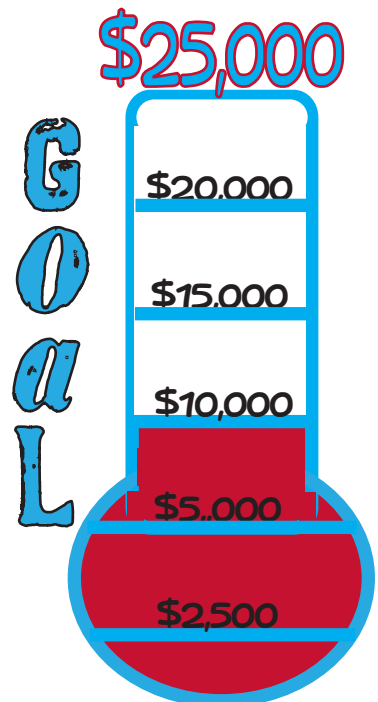

## ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM PRINCIPAL GREER

On October 20th, 1st grade will be hosting a blue jeans pass day in order to raise money for the technology centers in their classrooms. The blue jeans passes cost \$5 for staff and students. If a family has more than one child at LCS, each additional child only pays \$1 for the pass. A family with three children would pay \$7 for all three children to wear blue jeans to support the first grade technology initiative.

Our Penny Wars fundraiser will be underway this week. Between 8:00 and 8:10 a.m. each morning this week students will go to the gym to place change in jars held by Lincoln Charter School staff. Change has interesting point value during Penny Wars. On Monday pennies earn positive triple points. On Tuesday double negative points are awarded for silver money. On Wednesday double negative points are earned for currency and checks. Thursday is double positive points day for pennies. On Friday nothing doubles or triples. After the points are tabulated, the teacher from the team who qualifies for a flushing will be announced. A flushing is when students pour water from a bucket on the staff member. The flush will occur at Track Attack.

Accelerated Reader is being revamped for our readers. Starting second quarter our students will have full access to all AR tests in existence on the Accelerated Reader website. Thank you to the amazing volunteers who have been coming in to code our library books for AR levels and point values.
