

“It’s Snow Much FUNd!” Winter Contest

The PTO’s Eagles FUNd Factory will be having our second annual “It’s Snow Much FUNd!” Winter Contest at the elementary campus running January 18th through February 8th.

1. The grades will be divided into three teams. Kindergarten – 1st grade will be the first team, 2nd-3rd grades will be the second team, and 4th-5th grades will be the third team. The teams will compete to build their “snowman”. Each of the three snowmen will be “built” in the hallway near the teams’ classrooms.
2. The students can bring in Box Tops, Tyson Project A+ labels, Labels for Education, and My Coke Rewards to put in the collection buckets located in the hallway near the snowmen. Collection sheets for Box Tops and Labels for Education can be found at www.lincolncharter.org/denver-pto.
3. The teams will earn a part of their snowman for each 500 items collected (each box top, label, coke cap counts as one item).
4. Volunteers will check the collection buckets regularly to count how many items are there.
5. Prizes will be given as follows:
 - a. The team that collects the most overall items wins a sno-cone party for each of the classes on the team.
 - b. ***New this year:*** Any eBoxTops sent in will count as ***triple*** for this contest. Simply print out the page showing how many eBoxTops you have earned and send it in with your child. Please be sure your child’s name and teacher’s name are written on it. Visit www.boxtops4education.com/earn/Default.aspx to earn eBoxTops. In addition, ***all families that send in eBoxTops for this contest will be entered in a drawing for a gift card.*** Also, ***the teacher whose class sends in the most eBoxTops will win a gift card.***
 - c. The class that turns in the most Campbell’s labels over the course of the contest will get to choose a prize using the “Labels For Education” points. Prizes can be previewed at www.labelsforeducation.com/Merchandise-Catalog. Number of points awarded will be determined at the end of the contest.
 - d. The class that turns in the most Coke rewards over the course of the contest will get to choose a prize using the “Coke Rewards” points. Prizes can be previewed at www.mycokerewards.com/school-catalog. Number of points awarded will be determined at the end of the contest.
 - e. Certificates will be posted above the doors of the overall team winners.
