BOARD OF DIRECTORS POWERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Board is a representative body elected by the board, parents and teachers to provide for and oversee the operation of the schools.

In carrying out its functions, the Board will:

1. Select the Chief Administrator and support him/her in the discharge of his/her duties;
2. Establish general policies for the school in consultation with the administrative staff and in keeping with the wishes of the school community and the requirements of state law;
3. Hire, transfer, and terminate school personnel upon the recommendation of the Chief Administrator;
4. Require and evaluate the reports of the Chief Administrator or his/her designee, concerning the progress of the financial status of the school;
5. Adopt and revise an annual operating budget for the school and the foundation as recommended by the Chief Administrator or his/her designee;
6. Exercise no individual responsibility with respect to the school;
7. Refrain as an individual from commanding the services of any school employee;
8. Exert authority as board members only when acting as a board legally in session;
9. Comply personally with all the operating rules of the school when visiting the school's campuses;
10. Perform specific duties imposed upon the Board by state statutes, such as:
 - 1 Evaluating the performance of the Chief Administrator;

- 386491464 Handling legal matters such as leases, loans buildings, fund-raising and finance;
- 386491296 Handling matters affecting the school charter;
- 386491520 Maintaining the school's tax exempt 501(c)(3) status.
